Introduction



New and Extended Features

Collection Support in Limecraft Panel for Adobe Premiere


Earlier versions of the Limecraft panel displayed items in the panel as a flat list, the most recent on top. For users operating larger collections, the Limecraft Panel for Adobe Premiere now lists the collections and subcollections of a workspace, along with actions to create and edit (sub)collections, and a breadcrumb navigator.





Overview of Files in a Workspace

With this release, workspace administrators can access a 'File Overview' page from the Workspace Settings menu, to search on all file content using an extensive set of filters.






Enhanced Functionality

General Comments


With this release, the Limecraft Review Application now supports the creation of general comments, i.e. such comments are not tied to a particular timecode of the media being reviewed.





Additional enhancements

- (CP-304) Support timecode extraction from SEI messages in H264 video during ingest SEI messages are a special parameter that is specified for H. 264 and H. 265. SEI message may be used to specify how the frame should be displayed. To make sure subtitling import and confirm functions work as expected, we included interpretation of SEI messaging.
- (NL-6905) Hovering over a custom status indicator now shows a tooltip containing the label defined for that status.



Specific Fixes and Corrections

- (NL-6854) The use of custom status in filters is now more properly supported
- (NL-6863) Existing quick views are again properly available
